FINAL PREP AND PACKING (1-2 WEEKS OUT)

Essentials for your day O Confirm timing and details with all vendors Share your timeline with your celebrant, photographer, and any guests or witnesses Print your vows O Double-check you have all legal documents Pack rings, attire & accessories Prepare a small day-of essentials kit (e.g. tissues, safety pins) Check the forecast and confirm your backup plan if weather changes Schedule quiet time the day before to reconnect and ground yourselves

ON YOUR ELOPEMENT DAY

It's the big day:

- Eat something nourishing before you get ready
- Keep your timeline flexible trust your team to guide the flow
- Have your celebrant, ID, witnesses, and legal forms ready
- O Breathe deeply, take it slow, and be present with each other
- Let your photographer capture the emotion and the in-between moments
- O Celebrate your way a toast, a swim, a firepit, a dance
- Take a quiet moment after it all to reflect and anchor the memory
